Advancing global frontier research and cross-regional collaboration in astronomy, astrophysics, and space science - hands across the Asia-Pacific under the IAU

Important APRIM Updates since last circular:

- 1. We have received >570 abstracts.** *We are working hard to include as many talks as possible over multiple parallel sessions with others as posters.*
 - a. There are 14 plenary and 51 Invited speakers across 9 themes.*
 - b. With IAU and LSR travel grants we are helping 58 young and early career astrophysicists to attend from developing countries in the Asia Pacific*
- 2. Space Sustainability** – this theme has been elevated to a full parallel meeting now endorsed and supported by the International Academy of Astronautics: <https://iaaspace.org/event/space-debris-and-sustainability-conference-2026/> and the United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs (UNOOSA).
 - Topics include: Space Situational Awareness, Space Traffic Management and Debris Remediation Technologies,
 - Foci include: International co-operation and policy and efforts with addressing *the serious impacts on optical and radio astronomy*
- 3. Astronomy Public Outreach and Education** – *There is now also a full half-day specialist communication forum event added with the support of the HK Education Bureau and local Astronomical Societies (stay tuned for further details)*
- 4. Radio, mm and sub mm astronomy** – *There is now also a full half-day specialist SKAO event as part of this overall theme*

Remaining Key Dates for APRIM 2026

- 20th March 2026 – Deadline for visa assistance requests
- 4-8th May 2026 – Official conference dates
- Registrations will remain open until 17th April 2026 two weeks before the event: <https://aprim2026.org/registration/> but we will permit on-site registrations.

Will take place on Thursday 7th May in the HKU Grand Hall from 7pm. Tickets priced in 3 tiers: \$300, \$340 and \$380 HKD. About 800 tickets will be available and these will also be sold to the general public. So again if you do want to go to this concert we recommend booking early.
